



PROTOCOL FOR COTTON

- 1) OPTIONAL- In row with starters- 2 quarts of C-CAT per acre mixed with 5-10 gallons of solution.
- 2) PINHEAD SQUARE- foliar spray 2 quarts of C-CAT per acre mixed with 10 gallons of water. This application can be mixed with other sprays at that time.
- 3) FIRST BLOOM- foliar spray 2 quarts of C-CAT per acre mixed with 10 gallons of water. This application can be mixed with PIX application or insecticides.
- 4) MID BLOOM- approx. 3 weeks after first bloom- foliar spray 2 quarts of C-CAT per acre mixed with 10 gallons of water. This application can be mixed with PIX or insecticides.

Note: C-CAT can be mixed with Herbicides, Fungicides, and Insecticides. Always mix small amount for compatibility.

Caution: C-CAT can make herbicides and fungicides more active. Consult with a sales representative for more information.
